





## About the Course

**The CHC50121 – Diploma of Early Childhood Education and Care qualification is suited to the role of childhood educators who are responsible for designing and implementing curriculum in early childhood education and care services. You will be required to implement an approved learning framework within the requirements of the Education and Care Services National Regulations and the National Quality Standards.**

This course teaches you the skills and knowledge to provide appropriate education and care to children. You may choose to work under direct supervision or autonomously and may also be required to supervise others. Students who have successfully completed Certificate III in Early Childhood Education and Care will receive advance standing for this course.

The course is provided through On campus and Blended mode of delivery. It will be delivered over 1250 hours including theory, self-paced structured e-learning, simulation training and work-based training / Professional Experience Placement (PEP).

This course follows Competency-based training which is the concept that individuals learn at different rates as well as through different modes and different environments and that the skills and knowledge that a student has acquired previously are able to be formally recognised.

## Mode of Delivery

### On campus and Blended Delivery

Students are required to attend 20 hours of classes per week including simulation based assessment and professional experience placements.

20 contact hours per week will be delivered through synchronised Online learning which includes on-campus simulation based training and Professional experience placement.

Besides the above structured learning, students are advised that they will be required to do approximately 10 hours per week of unstructured learning.

The blended delivery mode is only available to domestic students on selected campuses and subject to eligibility.

Students must meet additional requirements for Professional Experience Placements as required such as a clear police check, working with children check & immunisations.

## Entry Requirements

Entry to this course is open to individuals who:

- hold a CHC30121 Certificate III in Early Childhood Education and Care or CHC30113 Certificate III in Early Childhood Education and Care.
- are 18 years old or above.

- holds International English Language Testing System (IELTS) examination (Academic) with a minimum total band score of 5.5 and minimum score of 5.0 in each of the four components of listening, reading, writing and speaking or meets equivalent English language proficiency requirements including ELICOS at upper intermediate level
- has successful completion of an ACSF test with demonstrated competence as per IHNA LLN requirements (issued within the last 12 months from the time of admission).
- It is also essential for students to possess basic computer skills.

### Additional requirement for professional experience placement (PEP):

- A satisfactory National Police Clearance/ Australian Federal Police Clearance Certificate (AFP)
- Working with children check (WWCC)
- Applicable immunisation certification such as COVID-19 Certificate.

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Where a student breaches the above requirements, they could be excluded from their practical placements which may result in unsuccessful completion of the course.
