The **BSB50420 – Diploma of Leadership and Management** equips individuals with the knowledge, practical skills, and experience needed to lead and manage across a variety of industries and business environments.

At this level, individuals demonstrate initiative and sound judgement in planning, organising, implementing, and overseeing both their own workload and that of others. Strong communication skills are used to support teams and individuals in meeting organisational goals and requirements.

Learners will also develop the ability to plan, design, apply, and evaluate solutions to unpredictable problems, while identifying, analysing, and synthesising information from various sources.

The course is provided through Online mode of delivery. It will be delivered over 964 hours including 828 hours of structured training and assessment which is inclusive of structured interactive learning, lectures, tutorials, and 136 hours of assessments.

This course follows Competency-based training which is the concept that individuals learn at different rates as well as through different modes and different environments and that the skills and knowledge that a student has acquired previously are able to be formally recognised.

Mode of Delivery

Online Delivery

20 contact hours per week will be delivered through synchronised Online learning and simulation based training.

Online mode of delivery of theory and simulation-based training will be achieved mostly through virtual classrooms.

Besides the above structured learning, students are advised that they will be required to do approximately 10 hours per week of unstructured learning.

Entry Requirements

There are no pre-requisites or any other training package entry requirements for this course.

IHNA Admission requirements

- 16 years of age and above at the time of commencement of the course
- Successful completion of an Australian Year 11 qualification or equivalent.

- Students below 18 years of age should have consent from their parents prior to getting enrolment in any courses.

Note: Mature age students (22+) will also be considered without the minimum education requirements. Each case will be reviewed individually to ascertain the capacity of the student to meet course requirements.

Additional Requirements

- Language, Literacy and Numeracy (LLN) requirement
- All students are required to undergo the LLN test offered by IHNA for their suitability to be determined for undertaking the qualification successfully. They are to demonstrate their competence in literacy and numeracy levels in the Australian Core Skills Framework (ACSF) at exit Level 3 and participate in a pre-training review when enrolling into the course.

Digital literacy

Computer or Laptop: Having access to a computer or laptop is typically essential for completing online modules, accessing course materials, and participating in virtual classes or discussions.

Where a student breaches the above requirements, they could be excluded from their practical placements which may result in unsuccessful completion of the course.
